a. FUTURE LAND USE MAP (FLUM) DISCUSSION:

The Centre Regional Planning Agency is in the process of updating the Centre Region Comprehensive Plan, which serves as the primary planning document for College, Ferguson, Halfmoon, Harris, and Patton Townships, and the Borough of State College. As part of the update process, the CRPA is requesting public and municipal input on the Future Land Use Map (FLUM). Earlier this evening, the CRPA hosted an open house to receive feedback from Harris Township residents.

A Future Land Use Map (FLUM) is a visual guide that shows how different areas of the community are planned to grow and develop over the next 20 years. It highlights where homes, businesses, parks, and other land uses are most appropriate, helping ensure growth is sustainable and well-organized. The FLUM reflects the community's vision and supports decision-making for future development.

Building on the Future Land Use Primer previously shared, the joint meeting is an opportunity for the Board of Supervisors and Planning Commission to consider how updated land use categories, regional development capacity, and community priorities should be reflected on the FLUM. CRPA Staff will facilitate discussion on key policy questions and tradeoffs associated with future land use decisions.

b. LETTER OF SUPPORT FOR REGIONAL TRANSIT STUDY:
